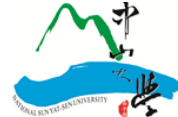

Judging of Poster at UT'19 Kaohsiung

Poster Preparation:

The format of the poster you present is requested as a **portrait form with A0 size** due to the size of the poster frame provided by the conference room. The portrait form with A0 size is highly recommended by the UT'19 judges. There is no requested layout for your poster. You can arrange your poster however you feel best to illustrate your research.

The on-site panel of judges will view and score the **Top 5** (at least) posters at UT'19 Kaohsiung during the student poster session on April 18 morning. The panel of judges will have no more than 10 minutes to view each poster and move onto the next poster. This includes a question and answer period.

Each candidate will be judged on the same criteria as listed below.

In scoring the presentations the judges will consider the following:

Poster Presentation:

1. **Timely Presentation:** Did the presenter explain the key concept(s) of the poster within the time allowed?
2. **Content:** Was the poster content presented clearly and concisely in a way that enhanced understanding of the written poster content? (Rather than just a verbatim reading of the poster itself.)
3. **Questions and Answers:** Did the presenter satisfactorily answer questions from the judges within the time allowed?
4. **Overall Presentation:** Was the presenter able to keep the judges' attention during the presentation and was the presentation easily understood? Did the presenter show an appropriate level of enthusiasm for the research?

Scoring

Each numbered criteria will be judged on a scale of 1 to 25 (with 25 being the best possible score; integers only). A maximum total score of 100 points is possible.
