

### **UT'19 Kaohsiung Student Poster Competition**

UT'19 invites undergraduate and graduate students to submit abstracts for the Student Poster Competition. Students are invited to send in ideas or designs for developing projects/products relating to the topics of the conference. The selected posters will be displayed during the conference in the Student Poster session. Following the conference, the paper will be published in IEEE Xplore. Selected applicants, based on abstract reviews, will have travel and expenses subsidized.

The work must be first submitted in the form of a 500-word or less abstract which must be received by the competition's organization committee no later than **November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. Notification of acceptance will be given by **December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.

#### Competition Rules:

- Poster authors must be either undergraduate or graduate students at the time of submission.
- The poster should be fully the work of the student or students and completed before they have received the degree.
- At least one author must attend the competition to present the poster.
- The poster must include the following:
  - # Title
  - # Names of author(s) and affiliated organization(s).
  - # Abstract (brief summary of objectives, methods, results, and conclusions).
  - # Background information
  - # Project objectives
  - # Materials and methods
  - # Results (tables, graphs, charts)
  - # Conclusions
  - # Discussion of possible future directions
